Ten years ago reggae/dancehall music was undergoing a revolution through fusion and Carmelo Miller was at the vanguard of this movement as half of the duo Route 76, which had hits produced by Sly and Robbie, Serani and the then up and coming DASECA. He is now set to launch his solo career with a brand new sound known as Reggae & Blues.

Carmelo Miller has released a mini EP with new music produced by Canada based producers Russell “Chuck” Morgan of Goods and Cargo and Nahgeib Miller for The Miller Creative Company. The first three songs will be available for purchase on iTunes and the other main digital music distribution sites.

As a member of Route 76, Carmelo Miller (then called Nags) would describe his musical style as “water”at once hard and soft when it needed to be. That has not changed but his mellifluous and soothing voice brings an earnest touch to affairs of the heart, mind and body that can get lost in translation from feeling to words. It is this hard edge of Reggae/dancehall enveloped by the sheath of the blues that make his new work so compelling and unique.
